

Small Businesses Operated by Tribal Governments or on Tribal Lands Presumptive Eligibility

OVERVIEW

The US Treasury presumes small businesses operated by Tribal governments or operating on Tribal Lands have been disproportionately impacted by the pandemic and, therefore, presumptively eligible to receive SLFRF-assistance. Businesses qualifying in this category must meet the definition of “small business concern” as it relates to Tribal governments:

1. Wholly-owned by one or more Indian tribal governments, or by a corporation that is wholly owned by one or more Indian tribal governments; or
2. Owned in part by one or more Indian tribal governments, or by a corporation that is wholly-owned by one or more Indian tribal governments, if all other owners are either US citizens or small businesses.

The following Oregon Tribes are recognized by the US Government:

- Burns Paiute Tribe
- Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians of Oregon
- Confederated Tribes of the Grand Ronde Community of Oregon
- Confederated Tribes of the Umatilla Indian Reservation
- Confederated Tribes of the Warm Springs Reservation of Oregon
- Coquille Indian Tribe
- Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Tribe of Indians
- Fort McDermitt Paiute and Shoshone Tribes of the Fort McDermitt Indian Reservation, Nevada and Oregon

No Tribal lands appear to fall within NCCC or SACC’s Service Areas; however, Tribal-owned businesses may be operating in either or both Service Areas. NCCC need only analyze and verify the data collected, that the business selecting eligibility is operated by a Tribal government, and the business meets the definition of small business concern as applies to Tribal governments, for the business to receive a small business assistance payment.

NCCC must treat Tribal-operated businesses identified by NCCC staff with the tourism, travel and hospitality industries as potentially presumptively eligible and subjected to the requirements in that section.

All applicants applying under the Small Businesses Operated by Tribal Governments or on Tribal Lands Presumptive Eligibility classification must be located in the North Clackamas Chamber’s service area: that includes only these Zip Codes: 97015, 97086, 97089, 97222 & 97267.
